The evening's program will include insightful presentations from Glynis Cassis, a licensed clinical social worker, along with David Krause and Kelvin Young, Recovery Support Specialists with lived experiences, who will share their personal journeys and expertise on healing. Attendees will learn about the facts and myths surrounding suicide, recognize warning signs, discover how to intervene to help loved ones, and experience the power of sound healing as a tool for recovery.

This in-person gathering is open to the public and will provide a safe space for open conversations and sharing of valuable information and resources. A complimentary community dinner from Restaurant Bricco will follow.
